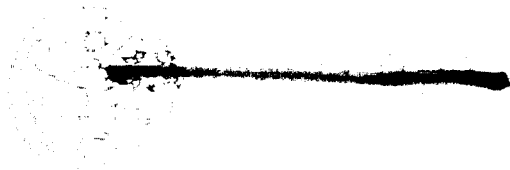

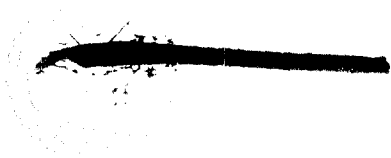

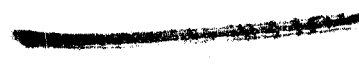

1. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the authority to make and alter the bylaws of the Corporation, and to cause the same to be recorded in the office of the Secretary of the Corporation, and to cause the same to be printed and distributed to the members of the Corporation.

2. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the authority to elect and remove the officers and directors of the Corporation, and to determine the powers and duties of the officers and directors of the Corporation.

3. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the authority to declare dividends or other distributions of the assets of the Corporation to the members of the Corporation, and to determine the manner and time of such distributions.

4. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the authority to borrow money for the Corporation, and to mortgage the assets of the Corporation to secure the same, and to issue bonds or other securities of the Corporation.

5. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the authority to enter into contracts, leases, and other agreements on behalf of the Corporation, and to execute and deliver any instrument which may be required for the carrying out of the business of the Corporation.

6. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the authority to do all such other and various acts and things as may be necessary or proper for the carrying out of the business of the Corporation.
