On June 19 the Commission approved a 40 bed cancer research hospital for Argonne National Laboratory and a contract for its construction was awarded to the University of Chicago. The new building, including Debatron, is expected to cost \$1,500,000. The construction has been provided out of the appropriations for the fiscal year appropriation specified by Congress for 1954.
