expected to exceed the cost for cleanup of Bikini. AEC and DOD each provided \$300,000 and DOI \$700,000. Because of the pressures being applied by the Eniwetok people, Ambassador Williams hopes that the necessary steps to perform the radiological survey and cleanup of the atoll can be compressed in time compared to Bikini where five years have passed before the islands were ready for return of the people. Both AEC and DOD can expect a request to participate in the survey and cleanup activity. DNA would serve as lead agency for the cleanup operation.
