The proper and secure handling of public information on test activities requires close coordination among the several agencies of government concerned. In order to avoid some of the difficulties encountered in connection with Operation CANISTER in May 1946, the Commander, JTF-3 (Operation GREENHOUSE) has recommended a detailed plan both for handling inquiries and for taking public announcements related to the tests.

A part of this plan was the release of March 20, coordinated through your office. The plan also calls for a joint announcement by the Department of Defense and AEC upon completion of the tests, and sets forth the clearance procedure to be followed in clearing this announcement.

The full public information plan recommended by the Commander JTF-3 has the concurrence of the Military Liaison Committee and the Atomic Energy Commission. Because of their interest, we are also sending copies of this plan to Mr. Johnson in the Department of State, and to the Central Intelligence Agency, through Mr. Kelly of the AEC Division of Intelligence.

For your consideration, we are forwarding herewith the following documents in this matter:
