1. Reference is made to your memorandum of January 23, 1950 in which the MLC requests the views of the Atomic Energy Commission on certain aspects of JCS 1998/13, January 7, 1950.

2. It would be appreciated if eight (8) additional copies of JCS 1998/13 could be made available for the Commission's use, at least three (3) of these would need to be retained.

3. Inasmuch as the stencils already exist in the subject paper, and at least 66 copies have been made, it may be possible for you to furnish the additional copies out of present stockpiles or to arrange for an additional run.
