1. Joint Task Force Three Report on Operation GREENHOUSE

General Quesada presented copies of the draft report of Joint Task Force Three on Operation GREENHOUSE. After the Commission had read the draft report, General Quesada commented considerations which had arisen during preparation of the report.

General McCormack proposed that the Commission in order reiterate its views as to the urgency of a weapons test at the scheduled time, address a letter to General Quesada which coube included in the report of Joint Task Force Three, and at the same time transmitted to the Military Liaison Committee. He viewed with the Commission the points which would be advanced such a letter.

Mr. Shugg pointed out that, even though policy consider ations might make a reference to the advantage of a standby contental test site unwise in connection with the report of Jo

Task Force Three, surveys for suitable sites should be pressed that an alternate location for the necessary tests in the spri of 1951 would be available in case later international developments should interfere with concuct of Operation GREENHOUSE at Eniwetok site.

After further discussion, the Commission:

- a. NOTED the draft report of Joint Task Force Three of Operation GREENHOUSE; and
- b. REQUESTED the Director of Military Application to vise the draft letter to General Quesada in the light of discussion at the meeting.
