

MEMORANDUM for the Commissioners.

You will have received an invitation from Mr. Carpenter to a dinner with the Secretaries of the Service Departments and the Joint Chiefs of Staff on June 19. You will perhaps have noted that in addition to General Hull's talk, there is laid on a brief presentation by "a representative of the Atomic Energy Commission."

I concurred in Mr. Carpenter's request for such a presentation. The Secretaries and the Joint Chiefs will not have heard directly from the AEC on this test. Mr. Carpenter wanted to make sure we got our day in court. I thought it would be a good idea from our point of view as well as from Mr. Carpenter's.

If Dr. Froman is in town, I would ask him to make a five minute talk. Failing Froman, then it would be Captain Russell or some other member of the scientific staff.
