PUBLIC RELEASE OF FILM "OPERATION SANDSTONE" (AEC 347)

2 Aug.

AEC 347 circulated for Commission consideration a report by the Associate Director, Public and Technical Information Service, regarding the problem of determining the advisability under present world conditions of the public release of the film "Operation Sandstone." The report recommended that the formission:

- a. Approve dispatch of a letter such as that in Appendix "A" to the President stating that it is the view of the Commission, with concurrence of the Department of State and Department of Defense, that the film "Operation Sandstone" not be released at this time.
- b. Note that the Department of State, MLC, Commander JTF-3, and former Commander JTF-7 be advised of this action by memo such as that indicated in Appendix "B".

27 July At Meeting 443 the Commission considered AEC 347 and:

Approved the recommendation of AEC 347.

28 July Letter such as that in Appendix "A" of AEC 347 dispatched to the President.

Memoranda such as that indicated in Appendix "B" of AEC 347 dispatched to the Department of State, MLC, Commander JTF-3, and former Commander JTF-7.
