Dear Mr. Bradbury:

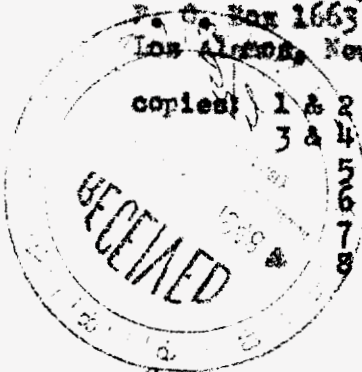
