It has been a privilege to work with you, and I look forward to continuing our association within the Commission.

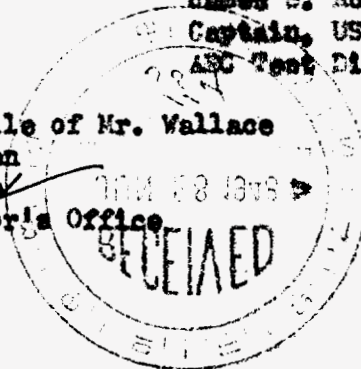
