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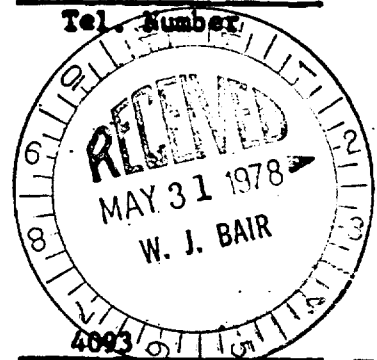

Progress on "a" and "f" - NV (possibly Roger Ray)


Item 7 - Long-term issues (viewed to include all DOE activities in the Marshall Islands).
