Please feel assured that I am more than happy over the possibility that Clint Mauhin may be given the assignment. I have discussed the matter at considerable length with John Servis and Dick House, and I can assure you that no differences of opinion exist among us.

My memo of May 26 was in considerable measure motivated by the hope that we could have a good telemetering program at a forthcoming test, and I felt that this was a good way to kill two birds with one stone. I still hope that ways and means can be found to include a telemetering program; this would cut down considerably on exposures of men doing early surveys of target areas.
