

## PRESS RELEASE ON OPERATION GREENHOUSE

## Note by the Secretary

1. On March 5, 1951, the Associate Director, Division of Information Services, submitted for the approval of the Commissioners and the General Manager a draft press release on Operation GREENHOUSE.
