I refer to your letter of 13 July 1950 concerning the schedule of the 1951 atomic weapons tests. The Joint Chiefs of Staff have agreed that the Eniwetok tests will be held on 15 April 1951 or the earliest practicable date thereafter, and the President has been so informed. I understand that you are familiar, through joint participation in Joint Task Force Three, with the change in scope of the test program as recommended by the Commander, Joint Task Force Three, to the Joint Chiefs of Staff on 21 August 1950.
