We think the best timing -- if you can arrange it -- will be for reporting session with the President to be held any time Monday, May 17, or the morning of Tuesday, May 18. We would advise Generate hold the Oahu press conference Tuesday 11 a.m. Honoiulu times (5 p.m. EDST). Are you still calculating that a public announce might be made by the Commission delegation immediately following to President; or would you think a formal White House press state following conference with President by an hour or two better; or a Commission announcement?

I'm inclined to favor the second alternative -- White House statissued shortly after Commission group reports to President. Reathat it identifies the report with the Maite House but does not any impression of shooting from the hip as talking with reporter emerging from President's office would.

So far we have reassured the public and the press by the very excare and precision of our statements on the proving ground opera.
