Dear Mr. Squires:

The Commission has recently determined that the following information may be published without undue or unreasonable risk to the common defense and security:

- 1. The fact that the thermonuclear fuel used in the Mike test (10/31/52) of the Ivy series was liquid deuterium.
- 2. The related fact that complex and bulky cryogenic equipment was associated with Mike.
- 3. The fact that the device fired in the Bravo test (2/28/54) of the Castle series used lithium deuteride as its thermonuclear fuel.
- 4. The yield of the King test (11/15/52) of the Ivy series was 500 KT.

Accordingly, this information has been declassified. This action has been coordinated with the Department of Defense.
