6. Congressional Disapproval of Funds for Enewetak Cleanup (Contact: DMA)

The Director, Defense Nuclear Agency (DNA), has advised that the conferees of the Armed Services Committees of the Senate and House, meeting on the military construction budget, have declined to approve the funds requested by the BOD for the cleanup of Enewetak Atoll. He reports that some members of Congress are apparently not convinced the United States is committed to carry out this project. These members are also concerned with the expected overall cost and the fact that the DOD proposals, when presented, were not sufficiently deftized. DNA will confer with appropriate United States officials and agencies as to next steps. If Congress agrees in principle, DNA will seek alternatives which would allow initiation of the cleanup project this year. (U)
