MARINE DEEP LAGOON SAMPLING RESUMED AFTER DEPARTURE OF USNS REFUELING SHIP. TWO SHIPEK SAMPLERS FROM PALUMBO HAVE NOT YET ARRIVED SO VARSH AND MCNABB WERE USING REGULAR GRAB SAMPLERS WITH GOOD SUCCESS IN YVONNE AREA.

LOW VOLUME AIP SAMPLERS SET UP ON YVONNE IN HOT SPOT AREA.

ENGINEERING/RAD SAFE GROUPS COMPLETED WORK ON ALICE, PELLE, CLARA, DAISY, EDNA, IRENE, AND PART OF YVONNE.

SURVEY PARTY RUBBER RAFT WAS LOST THURSDAY NIGHT. CREWMAN FROM REFUELING SHIP ENGAGED IN MIDNIGHT REQUISITION OFF PIER WHEN HE MISSED LAST LCPL TAXI, POWED TO SHIP, WHERE RAFT FLOATED OUT THROUGH WIDE PASSAGE IN DARK WHEN HE FELL OVERBOARD AND HAD TO BE RESCUED. DURING DISCUSSION SESSION IN SHIP CAPTAIN'S CABIN FRIDAY AFTERNOON, CHAIRED BY RESIDENT DEPUTY MARSHALL FOR THE TRUST TERRITORIES (FARKAS), CREWMAN ALLOWED AS HOW IT WAS ONLY FITTING AND PROPER THAT HE BUY US A NEW RAFT.
