IRENE, BELLE, AND URSULA. DATA ON FRED INDICATED TWO SMALL AREAS
SIGNIFICANTLY ABOVE BACKGROUND. A FIELD CHECK SHOWED ONE TO BE
A SMALL COBALT 60 SOURCE STORED IN A LOCKED BUILDING. IT BELONGS TO
USGS AND IS IN FARKADYS CUSTODY. THE SECOND SOURCE, (10 MICRO R, OR
APPROXIMATELY TEN TIMES BACKGROUND) WAS FOUND TO BE A STACK OF BARRELS
OF FLY ASH STORED IN THE PACE DRILLING EQUIPMENT WAREHOUSE. NO PROBLEM
